FREE UWG Campus Center Membership

UWG retirees have FREE access to the Campus Center! The center offers a 1/8 mile indoor walking/jogging track, cardiovascular machines and weights in the fitness center, aerobics rooms, basketball courts, and a 50 ft. climbing wall. To gain your free access follow the guidelines below.

Access to the facilities will begin upon completion of the registration process.

- Retirees must visit the Card Office located on the third floor of University Community Center (UCC) to turn in their prior UWG employee ID card to obtain a new UWG ID card that identifies them as "retiree." This allows Campus Center staff to ensure retirees receive appropriate access. UWG Card Office is open Mon-Fri, 8 am 5 pm.
- Retirees must then visit the UREC administration desk at the front of the Campus Center Mon-Fri, 8 am 7:30 pm to complete UREC account setup and gain facility access.
- IF you no longer have your UWG ID card, a replacement card must be purchased for a \$20 fee at UCC Card Office.

Please be advised that the Campus Center is funded by student fees.

• Programs and offerings are student-centered (types of classes offered, music played in facility, building hours, etc.). Only UWG retirees are eligible for this access; spouses and dependents are not eligible.

Retirees will not have access to the MyRec portal to make online reservations for fitness classes.

- Any registrations for group fitness classes can be accommodated in person at the UREC administration desk or by phone at 678-839-5500.
- Although you may show up at class time and register at the door, there is limited space available for each class. So we encourage registering in advance when possible.

In Memoriam: ARFS Coordinating Council Member, Dr. Robert M. Reeves.

Dr. Bob "Woody" Reeves, aged 82 died on January 1, 2020 after living a full life of continual service to the UWG community. Dr. Reeves was born in Demopolis Alabama in 1937, played football and was the recipient of both athletic and academic scholarships to numerous schools. He became an avid 'Bama" fan after eventually transferring to Alabama where he obtained his undergraduate, master's and doctorate. He taught physical education at UWG for 27 years and served as the men's and women's tennis coach for 7 years. Bob mastered ballroom dancing after taking lessons as early as the fifth grade and was known throughout the West Georgia Community where he shared his love of dance with hundreds of local citizens. After retirement

from UWG Bob became a personal trainer at Club Fitness and continued to participate in road races as late as 2018. He was an active member of the Kiwanis Club & First United Methodist Church and served as interim Bluefin Swim Team Coach several years. Contributions may be made to the Dr. Robert M. Reeves Scholarship Endowment Fund, which was started at his retirement by faculty and staff in the Physical Education Department.

Successful GA-HERO meeting in Newnan!

The GEORGIA Association of Higher Education Retiree Organization (GA-HERO) held their November meeting at the UWG Newnan Center on November 8, 2019. Dr. David Jenks, Interim Provost, welcomed the attendees and provided some historical background on the Newnan campus. UWG Retiree Legacy Scholarship — Accepting Applications

Don't miss this wonderful opportunity! ARFS would like to remind all retirees that the UWG Retiree Legacy Scholarship is currently accepting applications. We encourage you to share this information:

The deadline for incoming students is February 1st. Priority will be given to students who meet the deadline, but applicants will be considered until a candidate is selected. Retirees, if you know of family members who meet the criteria for this scholarship, invite them to apply!

Students need to go to the University of West Georgia scholarship portal and follow the instructions. Find the portal at http://www.westga.edu/scholarships. The portal allows students to apply for all UWG scholarships in the database. The computer matches and selects students who have applied with the criteria for all the various scholarships loaded into the database.

Eligibility Criteria for the UWG Retiree Legacy Scholarship

- Recipients will be full-time graduate or undergraduate students who are retirees of the institution or
 who are direct descendants or an immediate family relation of a retired faculty or staff member (with a
 minimum of 10 years of service to the institution).
- Recipients will have minimum cumulative GPA 2.5, with preference given to applicants with higher GPA.
- Preference will be given to applicants with a demonstrated financial need as determined by the UWG
 Financial Aid Office.

Emeritus faculty will be provided full library access (the same as active faculty).
